Cloned journals



Clone journal web pages are a counterfeit mirror of an authentic journal that exploit the title and ISSN of legitimate journals. In contrast to predatory journals, clone journals are more likely to accept papers from authors, since they have developed as the mirror image of reputable journals, including their domain name. Some of these counterfeit journals actively chase authors through a modified e-mail message that announces a fake call for papers in a current issue of the journal. Authors may be duped by these solicitations into paying an open-access publication fee, trusting that their work is about to be published in a reputable journal.

Predatory Journals



- Predatory publishing is called write-only publishing or deceptive publishing. It is an exploitive publishing business model that involves charging publication fees to authors without checking articles for quality and legitimacy and without providing the other editorial and publishing services that legitimate academic journals provide, whether open access or not.
- They are regarded as predatory because scholars are tricked into publishing with them, although some authors may be aware that the journal is poor quality or even fraudulent. New scholars from developing countries are said to be especially at risk of being misled by predatory publishers. According to one study, 60% of articles published in predatory journals receive no citations over the five-year period following publication.

Wrong Impact Factors

Only two impact Factors are to be considered

- (a) Cite Score by Elsevier (SCOPUS)
- (b) Journal Citation Report by Clarivate Analysis
(Web of Science)

Ten Red Flags for Predatory Journals

- 1) These journals will publish papers large number of Out of Purview papers.
- 2) These journals will publish papers without checking the quality and research work involved.
- 3) These journals will not have deadline to submit the papers.
- 4) These journals will publish the paper in maximum 48-72 hours.
- 5) These journals will use Gmail id's for their working.

Ten Red Flags for Predatory Journals

- 6) There will be no contact details on the website under the tab Contact Us.
- 7) There will be no information about the Editorial Board, many International names are cut, copied and pasted without their consent and official email id's.
- 8) These journals will always charge on the pretext of an Platinum/Gold Open Access model.
- 9) Most of these types of journals use Fake/Misleading Impact Factor/Metrics.
- 10) These journals will have very less or no citations in the last five years.

Ten Red Flags for Cloned Journals

- 1) These journals always operate with fake lookalike website of the original journal.
- 2) These journals will always use Fake/Misleading Impact Factor/Metrics to lure the faculties and researchers.
- 3) Cloned journals will publish the papers in less than 24 hours and sometimes in an hour after receiving the money.
- 4) These journals collect the money through international routes like Western Union, PayUMoney etc so that the trace of money laundering cannot be found.
- 5) There will be no information under the tab Contact Us on these journals

Ten Red Flags for Cloned Journals



- 6) There will be no information will about the Editorial Board, many International names are cut, copied and pasted without their consent and official email id's.
- 7) There will be paper brokers involved in this business and they will crack the deal with you on behalf of the cloned journals.
- 8) These journals will also publish any kind of plagiarized, fabricated paper after receiving the money.
- 9) These journals will always misuse the Logos of prominent companies like Elsevier, Clarivate, CrossRef, Emerald etc.
- 10) There will be simple grammatical on the website of the journal.
